- f. Graduated from Washington State Pullman, Washington, received BS degree in pharmacy in 1940.
- g. Pharmacy Technician.

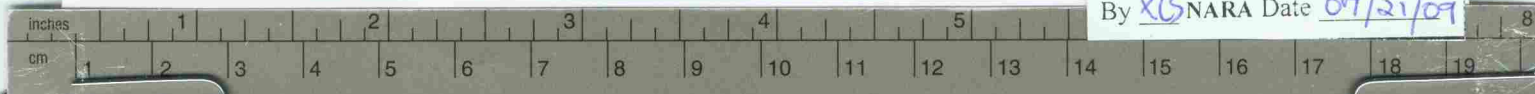
